REFERRED TO COMMITTEE

The petition of Samuel Titcomb and three others for the laying out of a new street, being an extension of Pearl Street was read and referred to the Committee on Highways and Sewers, and a hearing ordered for July 21, 1913, and sent down for concurrence, subsequently being returned by the Common Council, endorsed with concurrent action.

Petition

We the undersigned citizens and taxpayers respectfully petition and request that the following described way may be accepted as a street. Beginning at the intersection of the east line of Pearl Street with the north line of Quimby Street; thence running northerly at right angles to Quimby Street 756.11 (756 11/100) with a uniform width of 66 feet, being an extension of Pearl Street as now laid out; thence running easterly at right angles a distance of 62.99 (62 99/100) feet with a uniform width of 40 feet; thence running northerly at right angles at uniform width of 45 feet to North Belfast Avenue.

Also beginning at a point in the easterly line of the above street at the north west corner of land owned by E. L.Gedney; thence running easterly at right angles to the above contemplated street 442.97 (442 97/100) feet furnishing said Quimby Street; thence running easterly at right angles 460 feet at a uniform width of 50 feet.

ACCEPTED AND PASSED

WHEREAS, application is made to the City Council of the City Council of Augusta to layout, establish and accept as new streets and public ways, Pearl Street Extension from Quimby Street to Fowler Street so-called, and Fowler Street from Bangor Street to the eastern end of the lot of Charles Nichols abutting on Fowler Street as indicated by the plan presented with the order.

WHEREAS, the City Council has ordered that notice be given upon such application;

All persons interested are therefore notified of the intention of the City Council to layout and establish said streets and are further notified to appear before the Joint Committee of the City Council on Highways and Sewers being the Committee of the City Council having the matter in charge, at the Aldermen's Room, City Building, in said Augusta on October 8, 1923 at 2 o'clock in the afternoon at which time and place a hearing relative to the proposed laying out and establishing of said streets will be had.
