ORDERED, That the south and north lines of Munroe Street and the Street itself be extended easterly to the Kennebec River and the same is hereby laid out and accepted by the City as a Street. Provided however that this order shall not take effect until the owners of the land over which said extension shall pass, have filed in the office of the City Clerk, releases of all damages occasioned by extending said Street over their land.
