The Joint Standing Committee on Highways and Sewers to whom was referred the order that Pike Street accepted, having considered the matter therein, beg leave to report that Pike Street be accepted as a City Street and that grade lines be established, it being agreed by accompanying petition that the City shall be saved harmless from any damage caused abutters by any grade which may be established.

ORDERED, That Pike Street be accepted as a City Street, grade lines established, and said street to be graded, according to petition of W. W. Jackson and others.
