Whereas the City Council of the City of Augusta have been petitioned by James Savage to layout a street in said City beginning at a point on Lincoln Street just east of the dwelling house of Thomas Farnham and running southerly about twenty-five rods across land of said Savage to land belonging to the Heirs of the late Ruel Williams and the said Council at a session thereof on the 20th day of March ordered the City Clerk to give notice of the intention of said Council to layout said proposed street. All persons interested are hereby notified to appear before a committee of said Council at or near the house of Thomas Farnham on Lincoln Street on the 24th day of April at 1 o'clock p.m. when and where said Committee will proceed to layout said street.

I have this day posted up two true copies of the within notice in two public and conspicuous places in said Augusta and in the vicinity of the street within the named seven days prior to the time of the within named meeting as follows, viz:

Report of Committee on New Streets

The Committee on New Streets to whom was referred the petition of James Savage and others for a new street, and upon which notice was ordered have had the same under consideration, and report: That the City Clerk gave notice to layout said street, as prayed for, from as specified in the report by us to the City Clerk, which notice was posted on the 17th day of April 1869 notifying all persons interested to appear before a Committee of said Council at Thomas Farnham's house at 1 o'clock p.m. on the 26th day of April 1869 at which time and place your Committee met, and after viewing the route, hearing the petitions and considering the matter, laid out a public road or street as follows, viz:

Bounds and Admeasurements

Commencing in the south line of the road leading easterly from the top of Malta Hill past the dwelling house of James Savage at the north east corner of Thomas Farnham's lot and from; thence running southerly on a course at about right angles from said road, being the course of said Farnham's east line about three hundred and seventy-five feet to the land of the heirs of the late Ruel Williams. Said road to be fifty feet wide and east of said line.

On the 21st day of June 1869 your Committee filed with the City Clerk of said City the laying out of said street, with the bounds and admeasurements of said street, as above reported, and we have estimated the damages of laying out said street as follows viz:
