At a special meeting of the Inhabitants of the Town of Augusta qualified to vote in Town affairs legally notified and assembled at Winthrop Hall in said Augusta the second day of April A.D. 1849.

ARTICLE 4, To the Selectmen of Augusta

The undersigned Citizens of Augusta request you to layout a road commencing on the east side of State Street in the south line of land owned by William Norcross, running easterly by

the house of John Holmes and Mrs. Hill's to the west line of Michael Young's land, and lay your doings before the town for its acceptance.

Augusta February 16, 1849

Signed Clarissa Hill and five others

In pursuance of the foregoing petition the undersigned, Selectmen of Augusta have this day laid out the road following to wit: Commencing at the south west corner of William Norcross' land on the east side of State Street; thence South 61 degrees East two hundred forty-five feet to the south east corner of Clarissa Hill's land, said road laying south of said line, and is laid two rods wide.

Legal notice was given and no damages claimed.
