481 ORDERED, That the Municipal Officers of the City of Augusta, Maine, upon recommendation of the Augusta Planning Board and petition of Jeanine A. Dostie, vacate the following Proposed Town Way as depicted on Subdivision Plan named "Raymond Dostie Subdivision" dated September 1972 and recorded in the Kennebec County Registry of Deeds, Book of Plans, Plan Book 42 Page 60-60A.

Raymond Drive, as shown in subdivision plan named "Raymond Dostie Subdivision" 9/11/72 and recorded in the Kennebec County Registry of Deeds, Book of Plans, File 42, Page 60-60A.

Any person claiming an interest in this way must, within one year of the recording of the order, file a written claim thereof, under oath, in the Kennebec County Registry of Deeds, and must, within 180 days of the filing of the claim, commence an action in the Superior Court in Kennebec County, in accordance with the State of Maine Revised Statutes, Title 23, Section 3027-A.

The petitioner hereby agrees to hold the City of Augusta harmless of all damages for vacating said proposed Town Way.
