504 ORDERED, That a portion of Rice Avenue, description below, be discontinued.

A certain lot or parcel of land situated on the west side of the Kennebec River in Augusta, Maine more completely described as follows: Beginning at a point where the southwesterly line of Rice Avenue intersects the northwesterly line of Frank Street, as shown on Plan of Lots at Brookvale by A. G. Norcross, dated November 1913, on file in the Kennebec County Registry of Deeds in Plan Book 7, Pages 68-69; thence running North 52 degrees 18 minutes West, 250 feet to the westerly terminus of said Rice Avenue; thence running North 37 degrees 42 minutes East, 40 feet to the northeasterly line of Rice Avenue; thence running South 52 degrees 18 minutes East, 250 feet to a point opposite the point of beginning; thence running South 37 degrees 42 minutes West, 40 feet to the point of beginning.

Meaning and intending to describe that portion of Rice Avenue lying northwesterly of Frank Street.~
