581 ORDERED, That Ridge Road, description below, be accepted as a City Street.

A certain lot or parcel of land in Augusta, Kennebec County, Maine, bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a point that is North 61 degrees 35 minutes 34 seconds West, 20,00 feet from the southeasterly corner of land of Wm. Michael Salter formerly Avenue Associates, thence running North 30 degrees 30 minutes 00 seconds East, 241.26 feet to a point of curvature; thence running northerly on the arc of a 254.18 foot radius curve, 184.11 feet to a point of tangency; thence running North 11 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West, 71.05 feet to a point of curvature; thence running Northeasterly, on the arc of a 165.99 foot radius curve, 160.06 feet; thence running North 44 degrees 15 minutes 00 seconds East, 41.62 feet; thence running North 45 degrees 45 minutes 00 seconds West, 50.00 feet; thence running South 44 degrees 15 minutes 00 seconds West, 41.62 feet to a point of curvature; thence running on the arc of a 215.99 foot radius curve, 208.28 feet to a point of tangency; thence running South 11 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East, 71.05 feet to a point of curvature; thence running on the arc of a 204.18 foot radius curve, 147.89 feet to a point of tangency; thence running South 30 degrees 30 minutes 00 seconds West, 243.09 feet; thence running South 61 degrees 35 minutes 34 seconds East, 50.03 feet to the point of beginning.

Meaning and intending to describe a parcel of land 50.00 feet wide and 705.00 long, to be used as a City Street.
