At a Legal Annual Meeting of the Inhabitants of the Town of Augusta qualified to vote in town affairs holden at the Town House in said Augusta on Monday the sixth day of April A.D. 1835 at nine o'clock a.m.

ARTICLE 7 VOTED, To accept the road mentioned in this article as laid out by the Selectmen and described therein as follows, viz:

Leaving the County Road at the south east corner of Joseph Williams' orchard, and running North two degrees East, twenty-four rods to his north line; thence across Benjamin Morey's land, twenty-five and a half rods, to Owen Clark's land in the same direction.
