May 6, 1833

Road from Windsor by Togus Pond to Kennebec Bridge

Beginning in the west line of the road leading Dolloffs Corner in the Town of Windsor to Togus Mills in Hallowell, to at a stone monument marked "R" nearly down toward the foot of hill south of Samuel Davis' dwelling house; thence running North 68 degrees West 56 rods; thence North 55 1/2 degrees West 50 rods; North 64 3/5 degrees West 300 rods; North 64 3/4 degrees West 62 rods; South 45 degrees West 25 rods; thence West 78 degrees West 11 rods; South 60 degrees West 22 rods; thence South 86 degrees West 88 rods; South 89 degrees West 12 rods; North 41 degrees West 15 rods; South 77 degrees West 106 rods; North 88 degrees West 53 rods; North 63 degrees West 218 rods; North 66 degrees West 47 rods; North 73 1/2 degrees West 107 rods; thence North 69 degrees West 74 rods; thence North 56 degrees West 28 rods; North 78 degrees West 128 rods; North 73 degrees West 56 rods; North 55 degrees West 24 rods; North 31 degrees West 22 rods; North 43 degrees West 16 rods; North 71 degrees West 104 rods; North 66 degrees West 160 rods; North 69 degrees West 186 rods; North 77 1/2 degrees West 64 rods; South 88 degrees West 9 rods; South 62 degrees West 69 rods; South 59 2/3 degrees West 54 rods; thence North 72 degrees West 100 rods to a stone monument at the southeast corner of Judge Cony's garden. A stone monument marked "R" is erected at each angle. Said line is the north line of highway, said highway is 4 rods wide and lies contiguous to and on south side of said lines.
