351 ORDERED, That South Street so-called, extending from State Street to Sewall Street be accepted as a City Street upon compliance with the State of Maine Statutes, the City of Augusta Ordinances and upon proper execution of agreement drafted and approved by the Corporation Counsel. Said street to be 40 feet wide. (See Street Book for description.)

A certain lot or parcel of land situated on the westerly side of the river in Augusta, Maine. Beginning at a point in the westerly line of State Street and said point being the northeast corner of Lot #2 on Plan of Belmont Park; thence North 62 degrees 48 minutes West along the northerly side of Lots #2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 15 and 18 a distance of seven hundred fifty-one and fifty-eight hundredths (751.58 feet) to the easterly line of Sewall Street; thence northerly on the easterly line of Sewall Street forty and seven hundredths feet (40.07) to the southerly line of Lot #19; thence easterly along the southerly side of Lots #19, 35, 34, 45, 46, 64, 65, 84, and 85 a distance of seven hundred sixty-five and thirty-eight hundredths feet (765.38 feet) to the westerly line of State Street; thence southerly along the westerly line of State Street forty-one and fifty-nine hundredths feet (41.59 feet) to the point of beginning.

Meaning and intending to describe a parcel of land forty feet (40 feet) wide between State Street and Sewall Street.

Fowler is the owner in fee, being a street 40 feet in width and extending in a southerly direction from South Street to the Augusta-Hallowell line, be vacated. Said street is bounded on the north by South Street; on the east by land of said petitioner for a distance of 185 feet; on the south by said town line and on the west by Moody, et. al. for a distance of about 180 feet. Said vacation shall be without damages.

241 ORDERED, WHEREAS, The Augusta Municipal Officers have received a Petition brought by Joseph B. Poulin and Delores M. Poulin and for the vacation of the following proposed street in Belmont Park, and

WHEREAS, Due notice has been proved and the Municipal Officers are satisfied as to the allegations of said Petition and proof thereunder, it is ordered that the following proposed street be vacated under Chapter 96, Section 46 of the Revised Statutes without damages. Said Street being bounded and described as follows, to wit:

A certain lot or parcel of land in said Augusta on the southerly side of South Street and bounded on the north by said Street, on the west for a distance of 190 feet, more or less, by Lots 6, 7 and 8 according to the Belmont Park Plan recorded in the Kennebec Registry in Plan Book 7, Page 82, on the south by the Augusta-Hallowell line and on the east by Lot 5 on said Plan and a lot marked on said Plan as being owned by Pullen and having an easterly bound of 192 feet, more or less. Said premises are 40 feet, more or less, in width.
