REFERRED TO COMMITTEE

The following order was read and referred to the H. & S. Com. and ordered advertised for hearing Dec. 21st, (Plan attached)

A-196 ORDERED that Southern Avenue be accepted as a street as per plan and survey of Henry F. Hill 1930, of Southern Acres, property of V. E. Dunn Inc. Street is forty feet wide and to have twenty foot roadway in center and five foot sidewalks on either side with five foot lawn between sidewalks and roadway.

Sewer is already constructed and all abutters to same shall have free entry to sewer. The rough grades have been made for street and sidewalks and both have a straight flat surface, the grades of sidewalks are not to be changed and the center of street shall always be four inches below sidewalks. Street has been graded down to allow approximately one foot of gravel surfacing.

WHEREAS, application is made to the City Council of the City of Augusta to layout, establish and accept as a new street and public way, Southern Avenue, so-called, as per plan and survey of Henry F. Hill, September 1930, of Southern Acres, property of V. E. Dunn, Inc. Street is forty feet wide and to have twenty foot roadway in center and five foot sidewalks on either side with five foot lawn between sidewalks and roadway. Plan on file at the office of the City Clerk.

WHEREAS, the City Council has ordered that notice be given upon such application:

All persons interested are therefore notified of the intention of the City Council to layout and establish said street and are further notified to appear before the Joint Committee of the City Council on Highways and Sewers, being the committee of the City Council having the matter in charge, at the Aldermen's Room, City Hall, in said Augusta on December 21, 1931 at 7:30 p.m. at which time and place a hearing relative to the proposed laying out and establishing of said street will be had.
