

## **SPRING STREET**

Mar. 14, 1825

From Winthrop St. 19 R.W. of the S.W. cor. of the Town Ho. lot, to the road leading by Church Williams farm

Beg. in the N. line of rd. leading be town house at a dis. W.ly of 19 R. from S.W. cor. of town house lot; thence running N.ly in a line parallel with W.ly line of the st. leading by the dwelling house of Henry W. Fuller to the St. leading by the powder ho. thence westerly at right angles 38' the width of the st. thence S.ly in a line parallel with st. front of said Fuller's to road aforesaid, thence E.ly 38' to bounds begun at 1 which streets (this and Elm) are to be considered town ways.

Voted, to accept such of the road which has been laid out and reports by the Selectmen as are hereinafter described:

A street on the west side of the Kennebec River: Beginning in the northerly line of Winthrop Street at the distance westerly of twenty rods and 8 ft. from the southwesterly corner of The Town House lot; thence running in a line north northeast to the road leading by the old Powder House lot to church Williams farm and to be forty feet in width on the westerly side of the said line.
