A strip of land forty feet wide and 117.6 feet long in said Augusta being bounded on the north by Newland Avenue, on the east by Lot 198 in Newlands, on the south by a portion of Stanley Street and on the west by Lot 199 in said development, and being a portion of Stanley Street as laid out on Plan of Survey Newlands recorded in the Kennebec County Registry of Deeds. ORDER #408, That a certain lot or parcel of land situated on the east side of the river in Augusta, Maine: Beginning at the southeast corner of Lot #226 as shown on Plan of Newlands on file at the Kennebec County Registry of Deeds; thence northerly along the easterly side of Lots #226, 199 across Newland Avenue, along the easterly side of Lots #159, 132 across Longwood Avenue and along the easterly side of Lots #90 and 63, 745.6 feet to the northeast corner of Lot #63; thence easterly 40 feet to the northwest corner of Lot #62; thence southerly along the westerly line of Lots #62, 91, across Longwood Avenue, along the westerly side of Lots #131, 160, across Newland Avenue and along the westerly side of Lots #198 and 227, 745.4 feet to the southwest corner of Lot #227; thence westerly 40 feet to the point of beginning.

Meaning and intending to describe all of Stanley Street, so-called, as shown of above mentioned plan, said Stanley Street being 40 feet wide.
