PETITION, Of S. D. Mosher and others (as recorded in Journal No. 6, Page 98. Original Petition not on file) for a road from a point on the road leading from Vassalboro to Kennebec Bridge at the line of Henry Clark's land and running easterly on said Clark's land to Gideon Hallowell's land and; thence over said Hallowell's land to the Church Hill Road leading to Vassalboro and was received.

Read and Referred to the Joint Standing Committee on New Streets. Sent Down for Concurrence. Returned Referred in Concurrence.

The Joint Standing Committee on New Streets to whom was referred the Petition of S. D. Mosher and others, for a new street or road have had the same under consideration and ask leave to report. That in their opinion the road is much needed for the convenience of the public, and that the interest of our City would be promoted by its location and that they earnestly recommend that the prayer of the petition be granted.

D. Mosher and others and the City Clerk is here by instructed to issue notice for the same and that the Committee give an estimate of land damages and cost of road.

September 12, 1877

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Augusta have been petitioned by S. D. Mosher and others to layout a street or road in said City, commencing at the River Road on land of Henry Clark and running easterly on land of said Clark and land of Gideon Hallowell to and terminating at the road leading over Church Hill and the said Council at a session thereof, on the First day of September, 1877 ordered the City Clerk to give notice of the intention of said Council to layout said proposed street or road. All person interested are hereby notified to appear before a Committee of said Council at the house of S.D. Mosher in said Augusta on the 24 day of September next when and where said Committee will proceed to layout the same.

The Joint Standing Committee on New Streets to whom was referred the Petition of S. D. Mosher and others, for a road from a point on the road leading from Vassalboro to Kennebec Bridge at the line of Henry Clark's land and running easterly on said Clark's land and Gideon Hallowell's land to the Church Hill Road and upon which the City Clerk was directed to give notice by an order passed August 4, 1877.

REPORT: What in accordance with the notice of the City Clerk herewith returned, duly posted as appears by the return of the City Marshal thereon, the undersigned Committee on New Streets, met the parties on the 24th day of September, 1877 at two of the clock p.m. at the place named in said notice and from thence proceeded to view the routes, shown by the petitioners one on the northerly side Henry Clark's land and the other on the southerly side of said Clark's, and having that the southerly side was the most suitable place for the road, we laid out a road as prayed for in said petition as follows:

Commencing in the east line of the County road leading from Vassalboro to Kennebec Bridge at south west corner of Henry Clark's land; thence running South 63 degrees East on said Clark's south line two hundred and thirty rods to his south east corner to land of Gideon Hallowell; thence South 62 ½ degrees East forty-five rods to a stake in the westerly line of the Church Hill Road said 5 road to be three rods wide and on the northerly side of said line the damages to said Clark's premises we have appraised at the sum of ninety-six dollars and twenty-five cents and to said Hallowell he having waived all claim for damage none was awarded.

In Accordance with the City Ordinance in relation to the laying out of new streets, this description of the bounds and admeasurements of said road was filed with the City Clerk on the 28 day of September, 1877 being seven days prior to meeting of the City Council.
