

STONE STREET

1806 Beginning at the burying ground on the East side of the River, thence running N, 21 1/2 E. 78 R. to the top of the hill thence (N ?) 16 E. 188 R. to a cedar post in the fence near Rev. Mr. Stone's barn, thence N. 30 W. 18 R. to the Easterly line of the Co. Rd. thence on the line of said road 10 R. to the bridge. Said road is 4 rods wide.

1834 From S. mt. marked 'R' N. 18 E. along Co. Rd. 52 R. to a stone mt. 'R'(at Titcomb's Cor.) thence N. 15 W. 46 R. to stone mt. N. 20 W. 10 R. to stone mt. 'R' N 23 1/2 W. 48 R. to a stone mt. 'R' in the N. E. cor of Ruel Williams garden(Cony's Cor)

1835 ALTERATIONS

Commencing at a stone in the West side of rd. near ho. of late Dan'l Stone's thence N. 18 E. 10 R. to cor of said Stone's land to a stone marked R thence N. 40 W. 14 R. to stone 'R' 4 Rods wide and on east side of above line

STONE STREET

March 25, 1897

Ordered, That the name of Hospital Street, so called, be and hereby is discontinued from East Chestnut Street to Eastern Avenue, thereby leaving its northern terminus at Eastern Avenue, and that the title of Stone Street, so called, be and hereby is continued from East Chestnut to Eastern Avenue so that its Southern terminus shall be at Eastern Avenue.

May 9, 1901

The following order was Read and Passed and Sent Down for Concurrence and came back from the Common Council Read and Passed in Concurrence.

ORDERED, That the Committee on Highways and Sewers be hereby authorized and instructed to determine the line of Stone Street and locate the sidewalk on said street at the earliest practicable moment.

In Board of Aldermen

May 23, 1901

The Committee on Highways and Sewers, reported on the order relative to determining the line of Stone Street that the Committee have established the lines of Stone Street, as surveyed by the City Engineer. That to the outside of the sidewalk from Cony Street to Middle Street is established to be eight feet and one-half in width and from Middle Street, southward, to be eight feet in width.

Report Read and Accepted and Sent Down for Concurrence, subsequently coming back from the Common Council Read and Accepted in Concurrence.
