534 ORDERED, That Sturgis Lane, so-called, extending about 135 feet westerly of said Arsenal Street be accepted as a City Street, said street to be 30 feet wide.

**DESCRIPTION**

A certain lot or parcel of land on the east side of the river in Augusta, Maine: Beginning at an iron pipe at the northeasterly corner of land now or formerly owned by Hazel M. Wright as recorded in Book 597, Page 529 at the Kennebec County Registry of Deeds; thence North 62 degrees 00 minutes West along the northerly side of said Wright Lot and land now or formerly owned by Alexis Ouelette 132.20 feet to an iron pipe; thence North 7 degrees 36 minutes East 32 feet to a point in line with the southerly line of land now or formerly owned by Thomas S. Coughlin as recorded in Book 634, Page 52 at the above mentioned Kennebec County Registry of Deeds; thence South 62 degrees 00 minutes East in a line parallel with and 30 feet northerly of the first described line 143.35 feet to the westerly side of Arsenal Street; thence southerly along the westerly side of said Arsenal Street 30 feet to the iron pipe at the point of beginning.

Meaning and intending to describe a strip of land 30 feet wide extending about 135 feet westerly of the westerly line of said Arsenal Street to be known as Sturgis Lane.
