C-148 ORDERED, That Sunrise Circle (so-called) as described below, be accepted as a City Street, upon compliance with the State of Maine Statutes as amended, the City of Augusta Ordinances and upon proper execution of agreement drafted and approved by the Corporation Counsel. Said Street to be 40 feet wide.

DESCRIPTION

A certain lot or parcel of land situated on the westerly side of the Riverside Drive, so-called, on the east side of the river in Augusta, Maine: Beginning at an iron pipe on the westerly side of said Riverside Drive located 99.77 feet southerly of the southeast corner of land owned by Grace E. Batchelder; thence North 55 minutes West in a line parallel with the southerly line of said Batchelder property 600 feet; thence southerly along the easterly side of future proposed lots about 40 feet; thence easterly in a line parallel with the first described line and 40 feet southerly therefrom, measured at right angles, about 600 feet to the westerly line of said Riverside Drive; thence northerly along the westerly side of said Riverside Drive 41.53 feet to the point of beginning.

Meaning and intending to describe a parcel of land 40 feet wide and about 600 feet long to be used as a City Street and named Sunrise Circle.
