VOTED

At the annual meeting of the Inhabitants of Augusta, legally called and notified, held at Winthrop Hall in said Town on Monday the 12th day of March 1849, and by adjournment also on Monday the 2nd day of April A.D. 1849.

ARTICLE 27, The following are the bounds of Swan Street as laid out by the Selectmen in March 1849.

Beginning at a stone post in the northeast corner of Benjamin Swan's land on the eastside of Grove Street; thence South 28 degrees East three hundred seventy-three feet to the east line of land owned by the heirs of the late Isaac Bailey; thence South 30 degrees East eighty-five feet to the west line of Gage Street.
