READ AND PASSED

ORDER 405, A certain lot or parcel of land situated on the easterly side of the river in Augusta, Maine: Beginning at an iron pipe at the northeast corner of Lot #4 as shown on plan of Clifford Taber Development dated November 20, 1957 on file in Plan Book 20, Page 82, at the Kennebec County Registry of Deeds; thence North 58 degrees 36 feet West along the northerly side of said Lot #4 about 120 feet to an iron pipe at the northwest corner of said Lot #4; thence North 33 degrees 00 minutes East about 40 feet to an iron pipe at the southwest corner of Lot #5; thence South 58 degrees 36 minutes East about 120.7 feet to an iron pipe at the southeast corner of said Lot #5; thence southerly along the westerly side of Hospital Street, so-called, about 40 feet to the point of beginning.

Meaning and intending to describe a parcel of land known as Taber Street, said parcel being 40 feet wide and extending about 120 feet westerly of the westerly line of said Hospital Street.
