READ AND NOT PASSED

341 ORDERED, That Thomas Street, so-called, extending from Western Avenue 309.5 feet northerly and in accordance with Plan of Westfield Development be accepted as a City Street. Beginning in the southerly line of land formerly of J. E. Tibbetts, now of said Cleo T. Couture at the northeasterly corner of Lot #20, as shown on a Plan of Westfield Development, Outer Western Avenue, Augusta, Maine, dated October, 1940, recorded in Kennebec County Registry of Deeds in Plan Book 13 at Page 5; thence easterly in the southerly line of land formerly of J. E. Tibbetts forty feet (40'), more or less, to the westerly lines of Lots #24, #25, and #26, according to said Plan of said Westfield Development extended; thence southerly in the westerly line of Lots #24, #25, and #26 and said line extended 309.5 feet, more or less, to the northerly line of Western Avenue; thence westerly in the northerly line of Western Avenue forty feet (40'), more or less to the easterly side line of Lots #20, #21, #22, and #23, according to said Plan of said Westfield Development extended; thence northerly in the easterly line of said Lots #20, #21, #22, and #23 and said line extended to the point of beginning. Being a portion of the premises conveyed by Napoleon Jollicoeur to Cleo T. Couture by deed dated May 9, 1958 and recorded in said Registry of Deeds in Book 115 at Page 117.
