WHEREAS, application is made to the City Council of the City of Augusta, to layout, establish and accept as a new street and public way, Tobey Street, so-called, running westerly from North Chestnut Street to Prospect Street as indicated by a plan of W. W. Hill, dated November 13, 1931 and filed at the Office of the City Clerk.

WHEREAS, the City Council has ordered that notice be given upon such application;

All persons interested are therefore notified of the intention of the City Council to layout and establish said street and are further notified to appear before the Joint Committee of the City Council on Highways and Sewers, being the committee of the City Council having the matter in charge, at the Aldermen's Room City Hall, in said Augusta on December 21, 1931 at 7:30 p.m. at which time and place a hearing relative to the proposed laying out and establishing of said street will be had.
