REFERRED TO COMMITTEE

ORDERED, That the attached petition of J. W. Shorey and twenty others for a new street or public way from premises of Alvena M. Costello to Sewall Street be referred to the Standing Committee on Highways and Sewers to investigate and report the advisability of granting the petition and what should constitute the termini of said street or way if established.

We, the undersigned, residents in Belmont Park, owners of property therein and otherwise interested in the development thereof, hereby respectfully petition the City Council of Augusta to layout and establish a new street or public way, extending from premises of Alvena M. Costello, being Lot #120 at the intersection of Vaughn and John Streets, according to plan of Belmont Park to Sewall Street by the most convenient route.

Statement of Facts

At the present time the property of said Alvena M. Costello and adjacent lots have no means of ingress and egress to any public street which is suitable, land on account thereof the value and use of the premises is greatly decreased and the development thereof greatly hindered through the lack of a suitable way and of gas and water service and sewerage.

**READ AND PASSED**

352 ORDERED, That Vaughn Street, so-called, extending from South Grove Street to Sewall Street, be accepted as a City Street, upon compliance with the State of Maine Statutes, the City of Augusta Ordinances and upon proper execution of agreement drafted and approved by the Corporation Counsel. Said street to be 40 feet wide.

**DESCRIPTION**

A certain lot or parcel of land situated on the west side of the river in Augusta, Maine: Beginning at a point on the easterly side of Sewall Street, so-called on the northwest corner of Lot #116 as shown on Plan of Belmont Park recorded at the Kennebec County Registry of Deeds; thence South 62 degrees 48 minutes East along the northerly sides of Lots #116, 117, 120, 121 and 125 a distance of 428.49 feet to the northeast corner of Lot #126; thence North 27 degrees 12 minutes East along the westerly side of South Grove Street 40 feet to the southeast corner of Lot #171; thence North 62 degrees 48 minutes North along the southerly side of Lots #171, 172, 173 John Street, so-called, Lots #200 and 201 on the southwest corner of Lot #201; thence southerly along the easterly line of Sewall Street 40.07 feet to the point of beginning.

Meaning and intending to convey a strip of land known as Vaughn Street 40 feet wide extending from Sewall Street to South Grove Street as shown on above mentioned plan.

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
