PETITION of James N. Wade for a street to be laid out across land owned by the City of Augusta commencing 8 rods west of Sewall Street and opposite Page Street thence; running northerly on a line parallel with Sewall Street about 19 rods to a road now owned jointly by the City of Augusta and the petitioner. Mr. L. L. Welman agreeing to pay all expenses connected therewith.
