**READ AND ACCEPTED**

The joint standing committee on Highways and Sewers reported that the acceptance of the Extension of Washington Street and the laying out of Morse Street, Valley Street and Lincoln Street as laid out by the plan of Surveyor's description, are public necessities and recommend the passage of the accompanying respective orders.

ORDERED, That Washington Street as laid out by engineer's plans and admeasurements attached, be and hereby is accepted by the City. No land damage being assessed or allowed.

The foregoing Petition and Order of Notice thereon, were Read, the Petition Accepted, the Order of Notice Passed, both being Sent Down Concurrence subsequently being returned by the Common Council, Endorsed with Concurrent Action. Pursuant to the action of the City Council the following notice was given:

WHEREAS application has been made to the City Council of the City of Augusta to layout an extension to Washington Street, beginning at the corner of said Washington Street and Monroe Street, and running north a distance of three hundred feet (300 feet);

And WHEREAS said Council has directed an order of notice upon said application;

All persons interested are therefore notified of the intention of the City Council to layout said extension to said street and are hereby further notified to appear before the Joint Committee of the City Council on Highways and Sewers at the Aldermen's Room, City Building, in said Augusta, on Monday, the sixteenth day of June, A.D. 1913 at 7:30 o'clock in the afternoon, at which time and place a hearing relative to the proposed laying out of said extension to said street will be had.

READ AND PASSED

A-397 ORDERED, That Washington Street Extension, extending 75 feet from a point 300 feet northerly from Monroe Street, be accepted as a City Street. Said street to be 50 feet wide.

**Description**

A certain lot or parcel of land situated on the west side of the river in Augusta, Maine and described as follows.

Beginning at a point sixty feet (60') northerly of the intersection of the westerly line of Washington Street and the northerly line of River Street, said point being on the westerly

line of Washington Street as now accepted; thence northerly seventy-five feet (75') at an angle of 180 degrees with the existing street line of Washington Street; thence easterly at an angle of 90 degrees a distance of fifty feet (50'); thence southerly at an angle of 90 degrees a distance of seventy-five feet (75'); thence westerly at an angle of 90 degrees a distance of fifty feet (50') to the point of beginning.

Meaning and intending to describe a parcel of land fifty feet (50') wide and seventy-five feet (75') long.

Know All Men by These Presents,

That I, Evarist Boucher of Augusta, in the County of Kennebec and State of Maine

in consideration of one dollar and other valuable considerations

paid by Inhabitants of the City of Augusta, a body corporate and politic duly organized under the laws of Maine with its place of business in said Augusta, County of Kennebec and State of Maine

the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Inhabitants of the City of Augusta, its successors

and assigns forever, a certain lot or parcel of land bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the westerly side of Washington Street Extension, so-called, located three hundred (300') feet northerly from the northerly line of Monroe Street, so-called, said point being at the northerly end of said Washington Street Extension as accepted by the City of Augusta July 21, 1913; thence northerly along the westerly side of said Washington Street Extension extended northerly seventy-five (75') feet; thence easterly at right angle fifty (50') feet; thence southerly at right angle seventy-five (75') feet; thence westerly at right angle fifty (50') feet to the point of beginning; meaning and intending to convey a strip of land fifty (50') feet wide and seventy-five (75') feet long for a continuation of said Washington Street Extension northerly from its present termination.

The lot or parcel of land herein conveyed to revert to the grantor herein, his heirs and assigns, if ever discontinued as a street.

**Washington Street Extension**

January 14, 2002 (City Council Informational Meeting) Kelly Gray presented a list of changes in road/street names deleting the word "Extension" to City Council.
