A certain lot or parcel of land situated on the westerly side of the river in Augusta, Maine being the southerly part of West Sewall Street so-called as shown on Plan of a portion of property owned by S. D. Blaisdell on file at the Kennebec County Registry of Deeds; beginning at point on the northerly side of Blaisdell Street so-called, 325 feet westerly from the westerly line of Sewall Street at the south easterly corner of Lot 17 as shown on above mentioned plan; thence northerly along the easterly side of 17, 18, and a part of 19, 150 feet; thence easterly in a line parallel with the northerly side of Blaisdell Street 35 feet; thence southerly along the westerly side of Lots 14, 15 and a part of 16, 150 feet to the northerly side of Blaisdell Street at the south westerly corner of Lot #14; thence westerly along the northerly

side of Blaisdell Street 35 feet to the point of beginning; meaning and intending to describe a strip of land 35 feet wide extending 150 feet northerly from the northerly side of Blaisdell Street to be known as West Sewall Street.
