REFERRED TO COMMITTEE

A-242 ORDERED, That Westwood Road (Peachey Inc. Development) be accepted as a City Street, subject to the following conditions:

1. Peachey, Inc., deposit with the City the amount of \$2,000.00 as a partial payment for sewer construction, (balance of 50% of total cost of sewer construction to be completion of project.)
2. To guarantee the construction of 5 new dwellings to be completed and ready for occupancy not later than October 1, 1950, and an additional 7 dwellings to be completed and ready for occupancy not later than October 1, 1951, said dwellings to cost not less than \$8,000.00 apiece.
3. To furnish a bond satisfactory to the City Solicitor in the penal sum of \$2,000.00 as liquidated damages.
4. To make necessary road excavation and place 6" of gravel base under the direction of and to the satisfaction of the City Engineer.
5. Street to be accepted upon completion of (4) above and the completion of five (5) cellars by said developers.

A-389 ORDERED, That Westwood Road, so-called, extending from the north end of the present Westwood Road as accepted by the City of Augusta 200 feet northerly, be accepted as a City Street. Said street to be 50 feet wide.

A-389, Beginning at a point three hundred feet (300') north of the northeast corner of Lot #28 as shown on Plan of Westwood Corporation, Section I, by W. W. Hill, C. E. dated January 9, 1952, recorded in the Kennebec County Registry of Deeds, Plan Book 17, Page 100, said point being on the existing street line extended; thence northerly at an angle of 180 degrees to said existing street line a distance of two hundred feet (200'); thence easterly at an included angle of 90 degrees a distance of fifty feet (50'); thence southerly at an included angle of 90 degrees a distance of two hundred feet (200'); thence westerly at an included angle of 90 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds a distance of fifty feet (50') to the point of beginning.
