WINDSOR AVENUE

A certain lot or parcel of land situated on the east side of the river in Augusta, Maine: Beginning at a point on the northerly line of Windsor Avenue, so called, 613.32' easterly of the easterly side of Mayfair Street, so called, said point being at the southeasterly corner of Lot #72 on Plan of Mayfair Development as recorded in Book 22 Page 12 and 13 at the Kennebec County Registry of Deeds; thence continuing in the same line easterly along the southerly side of Lot #88 and across the southerly end of Windsor Lane, so called, 187.62' to the easterly side of said Windsor Lane at the southwest corner of Lot #94; thence southerly in the extension of the easterly line of said Windsor Lane 40.11' to the northerly line of Lot #95; thence westerly along the northerly line of Lots #95 and 87 to the northeast corner of Lot #73; thence at right angles northerly 40' to the point of beginning: Meaning and intending to describe a parcel of land 40' wide and about 188' long extending from the easterly end of Windsor Avenue as accepted May 4, 1959 easterly to the easterly side of Windsor Lane, so called, to be known as Windsor Avenue.

WINDSOR LANE

A certain lot or parcel of land situated on the east side of the river in Augusta, Maine: Beginning at a point on the southerly line of Second Avenue, so called, located 202.46' easterly of the northeast corner of Lot #46 said corner being on the easterly end of section of Second Ave. accepted Nov. 9, 1960; thence southerly at an angle of 85.45' with the southerly side of said Second Avenue and along the westerly side of Lots #93 and 94, 200.56'; thence westerly in a line parallel with the southerly side of said Second Avenue 40'; thence northerly parallel with the first described line 179.02' to the start of a curve to the west; thence northerly along said curve whose tangent is 21.54', radius 20' and length 32.90' to a point on the southerly side of said Second Avenue; thence easterly along the southerly side of said Second Avenue 61.54' to the point of beginning: Meaning and intending to describe a parcel of land 40' wide and about 200.56' long extending from the southerly side of said Second Avenue to the northerly side of Windsor Avenue, so called, to be known as Windsor Lane.
