VOTED

The Committee on New Streets to whom was referred the petition of Hiram Choate and others for a new street and upon which notice was ordered, have had the same under consideration and report: That the City Clerk gave notice to layout said street as prayed for from Northern Avenue to and terminating at the east line of Moses Choate and others, which notice was posted at the east end of the proposed street on the 11<sup>th</sup> of October 1867, notifying all persons interested to appear before a committee of said Council at house of Hiram Choate at 2 o'clock PM. of the 19<sup>th</sup> of October 1867, at which time and place your committee met and after viewing the route, hearing the petitioners and considering the matter laid out a public road or street as follows, viz: Commencing at the north east corner of land of Hiram Choate and others and from thence running North 67 ½ degrees West 200 minutes to Washington Street, and continuing the same line and course across Washington Street and from the westerly line thereof to Northern Avenue; said street to be 36 feet wide and on the northerly side of said line.

On the 19<sup>th</sup> day of October 1867, your Committee filed within City Clerk of said City, the laying out of said street and the bounds and admeasurements of said street as above reported, and we have estimated the damages of laying out of said street as follows, viz: None, it being a reservation for a street called York Street on a plan of the old Kennebec Dam Company's lands. All which is respectfully submitted.
