## CURBSIDE RECYCLING

### MATERIALS PREPARATION (must be separated)



#### **METAL FOOD AND BEVERAGE CANS:**

Rinse cans and remove labels. Flattening is preferred. NO aerosol spray cans, paint cans, aluminum foil, coat hangers, pots and pans or other metals!



#### **CLEAR GLASS BOTTLES & JARS:**




Rinse containers and remove caps. Labels are o.k. NO colored glass, drinking glasses, cookware, coffeepots, lightbulbs, windowpanes, mirrors or ceramics!



#### **NEWSPAPER/MAGAZINE/CATALOG MIX**

(including telephone books)



Clean, dry and bundled or in reusable container. NO unwanted mail, hardcover books, or boxes.

#### **#2 HDPE "CLEAR" PLASTIC CONTAINERS**



Rinse containers, remove caps and neck rings, and flatten. Look for recycling symbol on bottom. Milk containers are considered clear.

NO colored or white #2 HDPE or other plastics!

#### **UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS WILL NOT BE PICKED UP.**

**Please Note:** Residential corrugated cardboard is not picked up at the curb. It may be recycled at the recycling drop-off at Augusta Public Works.

## DROP-OFF AREAS

The following items may be recycled at these drop-off areas free of charge: (*Single Source Recycling*)

#### **PUBLIC WORKS, 55 North Street**

*Augusta residential recyclables only, NO COMMERCIAL.*

**Mon.-Fri. 7:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.:**

- Newspaper/Magazine/Catalog Mix
- Glass bottles and jars
- Metal Food and Beverage Cans
- #1 to #7 Plastic Containers
- Cardboard, paperboard, clean pizza boxes
- Office Paper, unwanted mail etc
- Shredded paper (put in a clear bag)
- Bagged leaves/grass (*5 bag limit*)
- Christmas Trees – Dec. 28 - Apr. 15 ONLY

#### **CITY CENTER, 16 Cony Street (back parking lot off Williams St.)**

*Augusta residential recyclables only, NO COMMERCIAL.*

- Newspaper/Magazine/Catalog Mix
- Glass bottles and jars
- Metal Food and Beverage Cans
- #1 to #7 Plastic Containers
- Cardboard, paperboard, clean pizzaboxes
- Office Paper, unwanted mail etc
- Shredded paper (put in a clear bag)

#### **HATCH HILL, South Belfast Avenue**

**Tues. – Sat. 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.**

- All recyclables listed above under Public Works may be recycled at Hatch Hill for a minimal fee
- Bagged leaves/grass
- Christmas Trees
- Residential TV's, Computer's, Fluorescent Bulbs and Mercury items. (*State law requires these items be recycled and can not be thrown away with your regular rubbish*)

## RULES IN GENERAL

Rubbish and Recyclables must be at the curb prior to 7:00 a.m. on your collection day but not earlier than 4:00 p.m. the day before. Containers must be removed from curbside by 9:00 p.m. the day of your collection. All rubbish must be in rubbish bags 4 cubic feet (15 gallon) or larger.

## LEAVES/GRASS CLIPPINGS REMINDER

Grass clippings and leaves are not collected curbside with your regular rubbish. Instead, bring them to Public Works or Hatch Hill for composting.

### FEE PER BAG PICKUP

Residents may buy stickers to have rubbish collected on your recycling week. \$1.00/ sticker for one 30 gal. bag. Stickers sold at City Center Treasurer/Clerk's office. Place the sticker(s) on the bag and place at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on your regular collection day.

## **BULKY ITEMS**

If you have items that you wish to dispose of that are not part of the regular weekly rubbish collection, a couple of options are:

- Take your items to the Hatch Hill Landfill. 3-trip residential passes are available at the scale house by showing proof of residency. This pass allows residents to make up to 3 trips per calendar year without having to purchase a 2 year Hatch Hill Permit. You will need to pay the tipping fee to dispose of your items; however the residential pass is free. For more information on these costs, please refer to the website listed below, or call 626-2440.
