Whereas, application has been made to the City Council of the said City of Augusta that Mitchell and Crooker Street be accepted as public highways and that the same may be laid out and established as new City Streets,

And whereas said Council has directed an order of notice upon said application.

All persons interested are therefor notified of the intention of the City Council to accept said streets and are further notified to appear before the Joint Committee of the City Council on Highways and Sewers at the Aldermen’s Room, City Building in said Augusta on Monday the 15<sup>th</sup> of December at 7:30 o’clock in the afternoon at which time and place a hearing relative to the acceptances of said streets will be held.

**BOUNDS AND ADMEASUREMENTS OF CROOKER STREET**

A strip of land thirty feet wide running from the north end of Mitchell Street westerly to Stone Street about 329 feet in length and bounded on the south by Lots #66 and 67 and on the north by the lot of Dr. V.T. Lathbury and Lots #69, 70, and 71 as shown on the plan of Fairview Addition filed in the Kennebec Registry of Deeds in 1917.
